### Perspective

#### The Central Core

The landscape surrounding the café, will be enhanced to provide a new eating terrace and square which will provide the setting for the new community building. Physical and visual links to the park beyond will be improved.

The Central Core lies at the heart of Bishops Park and has always been a gathering and events space. It is proposed to retain and strengthen this key function through the provision of a large circular hard paved area, similar in size to the existing and framed by ornamental trees with permanent and temporary seating. Surrounding this central area, are four contemporary play spaces set within a strong framework of paths, hedges, railings and gated entrances to reflect the parks historic layout.

1. Toddlers Play – fenced and gated, 870m<sup>2</sup> (existing play area 962m<sup>2</sup>) combining new equipment with existing to be relocated, all set within ‘garden setting’
2. Juniors Play – fenced and gated, 600m<sup>2</sup> (existing play area 100m<sup>2</sup>), combining new equipment and natural play opportunities.
3. New Teenage Area providing basketball, table tennis and seating ‘hang out’
4. New area laid to lawn, for informal gathering, picnic and kids kick-about.
