Restored Fulham Beach and Water Play

The scheme to improve Bishops Park, has always included the proposal to restore the Fulham Beach in the area currently occupied by the 'sandpit' and paddling pool. The importance of water play was also recognised, but earlier designs proposed interactive water fountains within the Central Core. Following consultation the proposals have been amended to include a fenced area of interactive water play behind the beach and close to toddler and Junior Play as well as the café. The ability to paddle in standing water is provided and separate pools of differing depth will provide greater opportunity for paddling for children of all ages. The total area of water in which to play will be greater than that at present.

Ample seating is provided for those supervising children. When the fountains are not operating, the pools will drain to leave a hard paved, undulating surface ideal for kids to cycle and skate.
