Restored Ornamental Lake

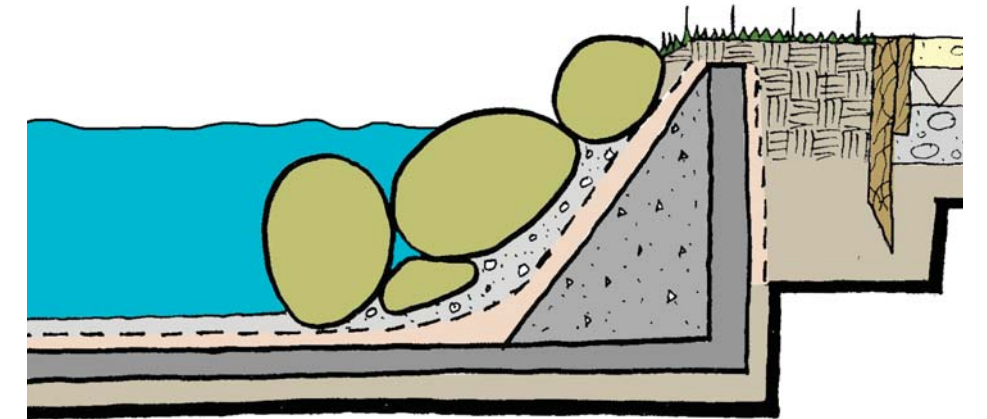
The Ornamental Lake and its edges will be fully restored. A new fountain will improve water quality and some existing trees which cast heavy shade over the lake will be removed.

The area currently used for children's play will be returned to a 'picnic lawn' with perimeter paths linking to a new rustic timber bridge over the lake, which will replace the existing derelict concrete stone structure.

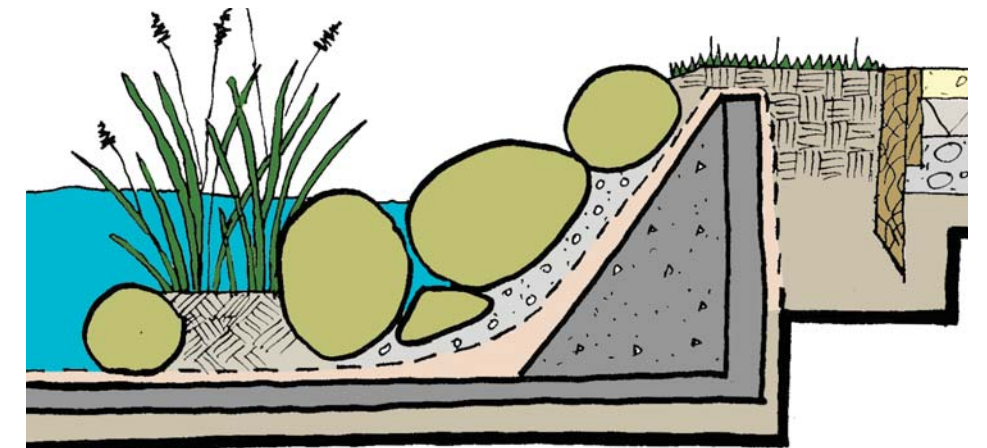
All paths will be surfaced using bound gravel. Sections of damaged terracotta balustrading will be repaired and a new seating shelter provided on the site of the existing.

The area will be fenced and gated to be dog free.

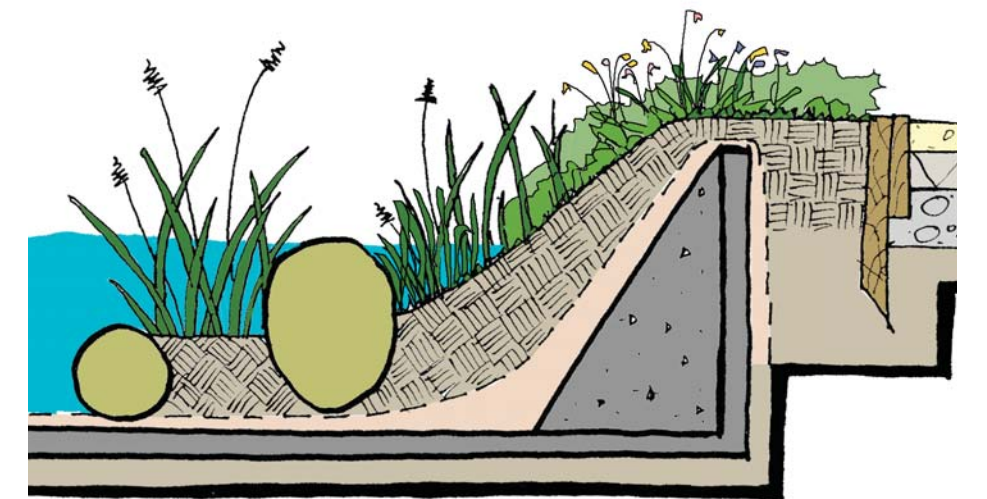
We will use a mixture of the following three edge treatments around the restored ornamental lake:



Restored lake edge treatment - Rocks



Restored lake edge treatment - Rocks with marginal planting



Restored lake edge treatment - Soft edge treatment with marginal planting, shrubs and herbaceous
