**Clem Attlee Petition for CCTV report**

Describe in full the aims, objectives and purpose of the proposal, including desired outcomes:

**The residents in and around Clem Attlee Estate are requesting an expansion of CCTV on the estate to reduce the incidence of anti-social behaviour and the fear of crime and to provide a more rapid response to incidents as they arise. The report acknowledges their request and explains that the work will proceed in the next two years.**

**The council and HFH are working together to tackle ASB –as part of this work the council are about to take over the management of CCTV across the borough from HFH. This will improve the service for residents because it will enable 24 hour live monitoring which is not currently available. It will also integrate the housing CCTV equipment within the overall CCTV network operating in the borough.**

**The feasibility study developed to establish the budget for works will need to be revised prior to implementation –costs could increase and this may be difficult to resource**

3. Could the proposal have a positive impact on **a) race b) disability c) gender d) sexual orientation e) age f) belief system groups?** (Please provide evidence e.g. user feedback, complaints, monitoring?)

**a) b) c) d) e) f) The proposal should have a positive effect on residents across all groups. In particular it could help to reduce the incidence of hate crime or other victim centred crimes and make it possible to produce evidence for prosecution if such incidents occur. The petition has been signed by a wide range of residents who have been prompted to complain because of their fear of inaction by the council in offering them more protection.**

**The Clem Attlee Estate is currently being identified as a priority for an extension of CCTV based upon figures of current ASB activity on the estate. Comparative monitoring information will be available after expansion has taken place.**

**a) b) c) d) e) f) There is unlikely to be a negative impact for residents other than those who are committing crimes and who will be more likely to be prosecuted as a result of this work. There may also be concerns from residents who believe that their civil liberties are reduced by the CCTV monitoring.**

5. Can any negative impact of the decision be justified?

**The negative impacts can be justified – the intention is to create safe places for people to live, visit and work and the CCTV system can provide an additional means to help meet this objective. All systems are subject to meeting the Home Office code of practice and legislation which will provide some reassurance to residents that the council will operate the systems professionally**
