**Decision to relinquish LBHF appointment rights to the Charity of Elizabeth Jane Jones**

**The trustees of the Charity of Elizabeth Jane Jones have asked the local authority to relinquish its nomination rights to the trustee board. Historically, LBHF could appoint up to four trustees because the founding benefactress was a Fulham resident. However, in recent years the authority has made no more than two appointments. Moreover, the charity has now relocated its accommodation to the village of Bedfont on the outer edge of LB Hounslow. It is unlikely that a H&F resident would benefit from this accommodation, and therefore it would be difficult to see how continuing to nominate trustees to the charity would fit in with corporate priorities.**
