## **WHO THE SERVICE IS FOR**

Anyone over the age of 18 who is affected by drug use - including drug users, their families and friends and professionals.

## **HOW TO GET THE SERVICE**

- Drop in (self referral).
- Referral from other agencies.

## **SERVICES**

- One to one key working sessions (appointments available on Wednesday evenings for individuals who work during the day).
- Open access/drop in (support, advice and information - no appointment necessary).
- One to one support for family and friends of anyone misusing drugs.
- Aftercare - one to one support offered to individuals wanting to maintain a drug-free lifestyle.
- Free needle exchange .
- Hepatitis testing and vaccination clinic (Tuesdays).
- Group work programme (12 week).
- Complimentary therapies (ear acupuncture and herbal teas).
- Confidential telephone support .
