

Earls Court Consultation: Section 105 of Housing Act 1985

The Council intends to consult all secure tenants on the West Kensington and Gibbs Green Estates on whether to include those Estates within the Earls Court redevelopment scheme by entering into a Conditional Land Sale Agreement with EC Properties. This is a “matter of housing management” that is likely substantially to affect secure tenants on the Estates for the purposes of Section 105 of the Housing Act 1985.

The Arrangements for this consultation are as follows:

- On or around **6 January 2012** all secure tenants on the Estates will be sent a “West Kensington and Gibbs Green Information Pack” summarising the issues involved and setting out the Councils’ proposals. This Pack will contain a Feedback Form.
- In addition, the Council will be holding a series of drop in sessions to explain the proposals.
- Secure tenants will be invited to make their views known to the Council by either filling in the Feedback Form, or entering your views on the Council’s website www.lbhf.gov.uk/westken or by writing to the Council at the address given on the Feedback Form.
- Secure tenants will have **6 weeks** to make their views known to the Council.
- The Information Pack and Feedback Form will be available, on request, in any language, large print and Braille.

Before making a final decision on this matter the Council will consider any representations made in accordance with these arrangements.

This Notice is published in accordance with Section 105(5) of the Housing Act 1985.
