



FIRE SAFETY IN YOUR PREMISES

Are you aware of your fire safety responsibilities under the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005 (FSO) ?

The Fire Safety Order (FSO), which has now replaced previous fire safety legislation (came into force 1st April 2006), applies to most premises other than single private dwellings.

The FSO emphasizes the duty of *'the responsible person'* who must take such general fire precautions as may be reasonably required in the circumstances to ensure that the premises are safe and must ensure that a **suitable & sufficient fire risk assessment** and associated emergency plan are implemented.

The local Fire and Rescue authorities have responsibility for the supervision and enforcement of the FSO and will require you to provide them with the above details when they inspect your premises.
