

Publication of Verification Number

Requirements for any petition for a referendum for a change of governance

Local Authorities (Referendums)(Petitions)(England) Regulations 2011
(SI 2011 No, 2914).

Under the above regulations, local authorities are obliged to publish a “verification number” which equates to the minimum number of signatures required on petitions requesting a referendum on the question of whether the Council should change to a different form of governance.

For the London Borough of Hammersmith & Fulham the minimum number of signatures is:

6,289

This represents 5% of local government electors shown in the current Register of Electors (updated on 1 February 2012). The number will be used to check any petition presented between 16 February 2012 and 31 March 2013.
