Guidance for voters

1. Go to the polling station at the time specified on the ballot paper. If you are unable to attend, you may apply for a proxy ballot paper.
2. At the polling station, you will be asked to show your photo ID card and to sign the electoral roll. You will then be given a ballot paper and a ballot box.
3. You will be asked to mark your ballot paper in private. The ballot paper will be placed in the ballot box and you will be given a receipt for it.
4. If you are unable to mark your ballot paper, you may ask the polling station staff to do so for you.

Important information

- You must mark your ballot paper in private.
- You must not discuss your vote with anyone else.
- You must not show your ballot paper to anyone else.
- You must not take your ballot paper out of the polling station.
