Guidance for voters

1. When you are given a ballot paper make sure it is stamped with the official mark.
2. Go to one of the compartments. Mark a cross (X) in the box on the right hand side of the ballot paper opposite the name of the candidates you are voting for.
3. Fold the paper in two. Show the official mark to the presiding officer, but do not let anyone see your vote. Put the ballot paper in the ballot box and leave the polling station.
4. Vote for no more than three candidates only. Put no other mark on the ballot paper, or your vote may not be counted.
5. If by mistake you spoil a ballot paper, show it to the presiding officer and ask for another one.

Warning to voters. It is against the law to:

- Use more than one ballot paper at a Council Election*
- Ask how a voter will or has voted
- Take a ballot paper out of the polling station
- Vote as another person* (impersonation)
- Show a vote to someone else
- Interfere with a ballot box
- Interfere with a voter when they are voting
- Deface or destroy a ballot paper, or the official mark
- Put any paper in a ballot box, except a ballot paper

There are penalties of a maximum fine of £5,000 or, up to two years in prison, an unlimited fine or both. Representation of the People Act 1983. * except as a formally appointed proxy
