WHAT IS A RACE CRIME?

Any behaviour (verbal or physical) that is motivated by hatred of another person simply because of their race, colour of their skin or their religion.

"A racist incident is any incident which is perceived to be racist by the victim or any other person."

RACE CRIME IS AGAINST THE LAW

Racial harassment is a criminal offence and should be reported. Offenders who are found guilty of carrying out a racist crime will receive a more severe penalty.

You can report an incident if you are a victim, witness, or a third party who has become aware of an incident. You can also report incidents without disclosing your identity.

In an emergency, if you need a police officer to attend, call 999.

ARE YOU EXPERIENCING:

- Verbal abuse?
- Physical assault?
- Damage to your home or property?
- Threats to harm you or your family?
- Rudeness about your religion?
- Graffiti?
- Written material?

HOW DO I REPORT AN INCIDENT?

We have set up third party reporting centres within the community where people can report racist crimes in a safe, friendly and familiar environment, to a case worker who will:

- provide help and advice
- respect your confidentiality
- monitor your situation
- refer you to other agencies if you wish
- take your case to the race hate incidents panel.

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER IT IS REPORTED?

When you report an incident, you will be given advice on the types of action that can be taken and the agencies, including the Police, that can help and support you in resolving the matter. Your case will be sent to the agencies that you have requested, for them to take action.

WHAT ACTION CAN BE TAKEN?

- Prosecuting the offender.
- Warning the offender.
- Signing Acceptable Behaviour Contracts.
- Obtaining an Anti-Social Behaviour Order (ASBO). This bans the offender from behaving in a certain way or from entering into specific areas.
- Injunction - A legal order which stops the offender acting anti-socially.

- Seeking a court order for possession of the property if a council tenant or a social landlord tenant is involved.
- Advice on extra security for you and your home.
- Priority transfer or emergency rehousing in extreme cases.

ANYONE CAN BE A VICTIM OF RACE OR RELIGIOUS HATE CRIME

If you or anyone you know is experiencing race or religious harassment, please report it NOW at any of the centres listed on the back of this card or you can call 020 8753 2458 to arrange for a report to be taken in your home.
