

The Benefits of Cycling

- Low cost.
- Faster than most forms of transport.
- Environmentally friendly (no pollution).
- Improved health and fitness.
- No parking problems or costs.

The council works to improve the safety of cyclists by developing cycle routes and lanes for the London Cycle Network Plus (LCN+). This network of safe and convenient cycle routes is shown on the map overleaf and can be identified by blue signs throughout the borough (pictured).



Cycling Tips

- Follow the Highway Code.
- Wear a helmet that fits properly.
- Maintain your bike in good condition (especially the brakes and tyres).
- Switch on your lights and wear bright clothing when visibility is poor.
- Take extra care in wet conditions.
- Take extra care at junctions, bends, entrances and near obstructions.
- Don't ride too close to pedestrians and ring your bell to avoid surprising them.
- Don't ride on pavements unless signs say you are allowed (see signs 5 and 6).
- Give way to pedestrians on shared paths.
- Don't ride through red traffic lights.

Cyclists have the same legal obligations and rights as every other road user, but remember you are more vulnerable on a bike than in a motor vehicle, and you can also easily frighten pedestrians.



Road Signs for Cyclists

1. Warning sign: cycle route ahead. 
2. No cycling. 
3. No motor vehicles. 
4. On- or off-road route or space for cyclists only. 
5. Off-road route for cyclists and pedestrians, not split into lanes. 
6. Off-road route for cyclists and pedestrians, split into lanes. 
7. On-road lane for buses, taxis and cyclists only. 
8. On-road lane for cyclists only. 
9. Recommended on-road route for cyclists. 
10. Two-way cycling permitted on a one-way street.

The Benefits of Walking

- No cost.
- Quickest way of travelling short distances.
- Environmentally friendly (no pollution).
- Improved health and fitness.

- Encourages you to spend your money locally and improves the local economy.
- Helps you get to know the borough and the community.

Walking is the easiest and cheapest way of getting around. It also brings you closer to your surroundings and the people in your community compared with driving a vehicle or even riding a bike. Research has shown that walking for 30 minutes, five times a week significantly reduces the risk of heart disease.



Walking Tips

- Set yourself a target of changing one or two of your regular short car journeys into walking trips; and keep to it!
- Walk to work, the shops, gym, station or to visit friends.
- If you have children, walk with them to school. You could even start a 'walking bus' and join other children on the way.
- Help us to improve your favourite walking routes by letting us know where repairs are needed or where new lighting could help.



Off-Road Walking Routes



- **Ravenscourt Park** – once the grounds of a large house that was destroyed in WWII, this park offers a quiet route between Goldhawk Road and King Street.
- **Wormwood Scrubs (& Little Wormwood Scrubs)** – this enormous open space provides a unique habitat for wildlife and many opportunities for off-road walking and cycling.
- **Shepherds Bush Common** – once used as a resting place by shepherds driving their flocks to market, this green features useful routes for avoiding the busy roads that surround it. *Note: also has cycle paths.*
- **Bishops Park** – part of the Thames Riverwalk, this park features Fulham Palace, the historic residence of the Bishops of London which is open to the public. *Note: also has cycle paths.*
- **Hammersmith Park** – a good route to bypass the busy Wood Lane, this park includes a Japanese water garden which is one of the few remnants of the 1910 Japan-British Exhibition at White City.
