Change of age range at Queensmill Special School

1. Notice is given in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that Hammersmith and Fulham Council intends to make a prescribed alteration to Queensmill Community Special School, Clancarty Road, Fulham, London SW6 3AA from 31 August 2009.
2. Queensmill School is a community special day school for pupils aged 3 to 11 years who have severe language and communication difficulties including diagnosed autism. The proposal is to change and extend the age range of the school to 3 to 19 years.
