

Bid for a Home

Council tenants and households on the housing register can search and bid for council and housing association properties via Housing Online.

First you need to log into or register for My Account. You will only need to register once. For more information about this, please go to www.lbhf.gov.uk/hol-guides, and see the user guide entitled Registration & updating details.

Once you have logged into or registered for My Account you can set up your Housing Online account and access Bid for a Home, where you will be able to search and bid for properties you are eligible for.

You need to have a housing register reference number or your tenancy reference number to set up a Housing Online account. If you are not a council tenant or on the housing register, please see the following to understand if you are eligible to join: www.lbhf.gov.uk/housingregister.

Purpose of this guide

This guide is intended to provide a step-by-step guide on how to place a bid on a council or housing association property, using our new online system. 

1. Log in to Housing Online and click on the **Bid for a Home** tile.






- 1. On the Bid for a Home screen, you can view your applicant details such as:











How to use auto-bid



1. Auto-bid is a smart feature within Bid for a Home that allows the system to bid on your behalf.

The system will automatically place up to 3 bids each week on eligible properties which match your chosen property preferences. To opt in and select your preferences, you will need to complete the online Auto-bid Preferences form through our website here: www.lbhf.gov.uk/bid-home.

This form can only be completed by users with a current Housing Register application and have registered for Housing Online.
