	The Chair welcomed all to the meeting.

4	SACRE Report Update	
	IN Provided an update regarding the report, and explained that confirmation was being received from DfE. All information required has been added as well as the Workforce Data – this explains how much time is given to RE within the Borough – School names were removed. Z's mean the school does not include RE within their teachings. Agreed syllabus recommends 5% curriculum time for RE. 1 school is teaching at nearly 8% curriculum time.	
	Other than 2 schools there is a full GCSE RS course. Oracy in these schools are very high.	
	Report is complete and can be circulated, and put on the website.	
	MN – Do schools understand the amount of work that goes into these reports?	
	IN – No but we can draft something.	
5	Audit – What Teachers are Teaching Look at what teachers in H&F are teaching. We spoke about a questionnaire, which I have put together.	
	Form was discussed with SACRE members.	
5	Local & National Update Today the curriculum and assessment interim report. RE has a section, feeling is that RE is not being taught correctly and that there isn't any national content standards. This will be looked at.	
	RE Council has put together an RE Standard to go forward for National Content Standard.	
	This will mean a change in legislation. RE is compulsory for all pupils up to 18 but there is a lack of national standards which has lead to varying degrees in teaching – there needs to be a high content for all and a degree of flexibility within schools.	

	Final report with recommendations will be published in the Autumn.  Survey of primary schools and the teachers feel confident with the Abrahamic religions but not so much with the Dharmic faiths. 42% of primary coordinator have done the role for more than 4 years. New program for humanism to help teach non religious world views. Still grants available for up to £600 for Christianity teachings.		
	There is a lot about belonging and inclusion and social change.

7	Developing Diversity Bid  Westhill Bid – money/grant for promoting a project within your LA which promotes diversity or religions and is asking to be done in a creative way, H&F is diverse and inclusive, so good opportunity to get involved.
