- Any alteration to the roof profile or roof covering materials of the dwelling house.
- The demolition, or alteration of part of, a front gable or dormer, and its associated window.

AND WHEREAS the Council considers that development of the said description would be prejudicial to the proper planning of their area and would constitute a threat to the amenities of their area and that the provisions of paragraph 4 of article 5 of the Town and County Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 apply,

NOW THEREFORE the said Council in pursuance of the power conferred on it by article 4(1) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 hereby direct that the permission granted by article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to development on the said land of the description(s) set out in the Schedule below.

THIS DIRECTION is made under article 4 (1) of the said Order and, in accordance with article 5(4), shall remain in force until 2.1 . I 409. I 200 and shall then expire unless it has been approved by the Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions.

SCHEDULE

The Classes of Development to which the Direction applies are :-

Any alteration to the roof profile or roof covering materials of a dwelling house, being development comprised within Class C of Part 1 of Schedule 2 to the said Order and not being development comprised within any other Class.

Any building operation consisting of the demolition or alteration of part of a front gable or dormer, and its associated window, being development comprised within Class A of Part 31 of Schedule 2 to the said Order and not being development comprised within any other Class.
