

- 1. WHEREAS the Council of the London Borough of Hammersmith and Fulham (hereinafter called "the Council") is the appropriate local planning authority for the purposes of Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 and the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1977 (hereinafter called "the 1971 Act" and "the Development Order" respectively).
- 2. AND WHEREAS in the opinion of the Council any development of the description contained in Schedule 1 hereunder to the dwellinghouses shown coloured red upon the plan annexed hereto, within the area described in Schedule II hereunder, would be prejudicial to the proper planning of the area and/or would constitute a threat to the amenities of the area AND FURTHER the Council consider that such development should therefore be subject to control by the Council.
- 3. NOW THEREFORE TAKE NOTICE that the dwellinghouses shown coloured red upon the plan annexed hereto shall be subject to control by virtue of this Direction made under Article 4(i) of the Development Order. The effect of this Direction is that, notwithstanding the provisions of Article 3 of the Development Order the development of the description contained in Schedule 1 hereunder may not be carried out without planning permission granted either by the Council or by the Secretary of State for the Environment under the 1971 Act.
- THIS DIRECTION may be cited as the London Borough of Hammersmith and Fulham (St. Peters Grove and Standish Road) Town and Country Planning Direction No. 1

SCHEDULE I

The classes of development to which this Direction applies in the erection of any structure at ground or first floor level at the rear of the main building Wall (such wall being indicated by a broken black line on the plan annexed hereto) being development included within Class 1(1) of the First Schedule to the Development Order and not being development within any other class.
