REMINDER - CLOSED ROAD RUNNING EVENT ON SUNDAY 18TH MARCH 2018

WHAT? WHEN? WHERE?

The inaugural Fulham 10K, in aid of Great Ormond Street Hospital, will take place on Sunday 18th March from Eel Brook Common, with its route exploring a range of roads across the borough. Please see map overleaf.

ROAD CLOSURES WILL AFFECT YOUR AREA

The route and road closure timings overleaf have been carefully considered and selected through a partnership of all local authorities, emergency services and Transport for London to minimise the inconveniences of the necessary road closures. Bus diversions will also be in place for the event so please do visit www.tfl.gov.uk to see if your public transport journey by bus is affected.

Further to the event leaflet circulated in January, this letter includes greater detail (on the map overleaf) of the exact road closure and reopening times as well as key local egress routes that will be available from 07:00 – 08:50 across the entire event footprint. We hope this will enable movement on the morning of the event if leaving your property from a road affected by closure. Event Stewards will be in place across the route during all closure times to assist you should you need.

Since our January circulation, we have listened to feedback from your Local Councillors as well as other residents and in order to try and keep disruption to a minimum and open roads as soon as possible we have now split the route into 3 areas with individual reopening times. Whilst these closure times have been established to assist your planning on the day, we will endeavour to open all roads as early as possible, with our clear up teams following the final runner to remove all event infrastructure and cleanse the route promptly.

Listed below are the roads used by the route in the order they are used with their specific closure and reopening times. Where roads are listed multiple times, please refer to the map overleaf which highlights where and at what time that road is expected to be closed. A full list of every road affected by the closures can be found on our website (www.adidascityruns.com/fulham).

Sector 1 - Closure Time 07:00-11:45: New King's Road, Buer Road, Rigault Road, Burlington Road, Fulham Road, Munster Road, Dawes Road

Sector 2 - Closure Time 07:00-12:15: North End Road, Vanston Place, Jerdan Place, Fulham Broadway, Fulham Road, Stamford Bridge, Barclay Road, Effie Road, Harwood Road

Sector 3 - Closure Time 07:00-12:30: Fulham Road, Munster Road, New King's Road, Parsons Green, Parsons Green Lane

We are working with social carers, local services such as meals on wheels and community nurses to allow access during closure times where possible. If you have plans that you think may be impacted by the planned road closures which cannot be amended, such as travel arrangements, formal events or carer responsibilities we strongly recommend residents to please contact us prior to the event and we will assist wherever possible to our best endeavours. The contact details below will also be in operation on Sunday 18th March should unplanned requirements unfold needing assistance.



There will be some very localised amplified sound on the morning of the event. Local residents to areas that will experience amplified sound will be contacted 2 weeks prior to the event with full details of the timings and limits in place, this is in line with the licensing threshold for a residential area and in agreement with the local council.
