NOTICE OF ELECTION

An election is to be held for a Member of Parliament for the Hammersmith Constituency

Obtaining nomination papers

1. Nomination papers may be obtained from the Acting Returning Officer at the Electoral Services Office, Room 28, Hammersmith Town Hall, King Street, London, W6 9JU. The Acting Returning Officer will, at any elector's request, give advice on the completion of a nomination paper.

Delivery of nomination papers

2. Nomination papers and a deposit of £500, in legal tender or by bankers draft, must be delivered to the Acting Returning Officer at the Electoral Services Office, Room 28, Hammersmith Town Hall, King Street, London W6 9JU between 10am and 4pm on any weekday, excluding Bank Holidays, after the date of this Notice but no later than **4pm, Thursday 11 May 2017**.

Voter registration

3. Applications to to be included in the Register of Electors for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer no later than **Monday 22 May 2017**.

Postal and proxy voting

4. New applications to vote by post, or to cancel or amend postal votes, or changes from postal to proxy voting (or vice versa) must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm, Tuesday 23 May 2017**.
5. New applications to vote by proxy must reach the Electoral Registration Officer before **5pm, Wednesday 31 May 2017**.
6. Applications to vote by emergency proxy because of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm on Thursday 8 June 2017**. The physical incapacity must have occurred **after 5pm on Wednesday 31 May 2017**. To apply for work or service reasons, the person must have become aware they cannot go to the polling station in person **after 5pm on Wednesday 31 May 2017**.
