### CPZ B and E Parking consultations

I am writing about the parking consultation we held last November and to let you know the changes we are making to parking controls in your area.

#### Results

We received 810 responses to the consultation from across zones B and E. In zone E, 66.4 per cent of respondents wanted Sunday controls to be introduced. In CPZ B, the majority of the zone was in favour of introducing parking controls on Saturdays and Sundays, but most respondents in the streets furthest from Olympia were against weekend controls.

In order to make the changes that most people want to see, we've listened carefully to all the feedback from the consultation and from ward councillors' meetings with residents' associations. As a result, we are proposing to extend parking controls in some parts of zones B and E and not others.

#### What is changing?

Included in this letter is a map showing the new parking arrangements. Please use this to identify your street and what your new parking controls will be.

All the roads in the brown area:

- These roads are within zone E with controls on Monday to Saturday from 9am to 8.30pm.
- These roads will remain in zone E, with controls extended to operate on Monday to **Sunday** from 9am to **8pm**.
- There will be a two-hour maximum pay-and-display stay that operates at all times. This does not affect Smart Visitor Permits.

All the roads in the pink area:

- These roads are within zone E with controls on Monday to Saturday from 9am to 8.30pm.
- These roads will become part of zone A (inside the blue dotted line) and controls will operate on Monday to **Saturday** from 9am to **6.30pm**.

All the roads in the yellow area:

- These roads are within zone B with controls on Monday to Friday from 9am to 6pm.
- They will continue to be in zone B but will operate on Monday to **Sunday** from 9am to **7pm**.
- There will be a two-hour maximum pay-and-display stay that operates at all times. This does not affect Smart Visitor Permits.
- Permit holders for zone B will be able to park in both the yellow and green areas.

All the roads in the green area:

- These roads are within zone B with controls on Monday to Friday from 9am to 6pm.
- They will become a new zone BB with controls **staying the same**.
- Permit holders from zone BB will be able to park in both the yellow and green areas.

### **What happens next?**

We will be introducing these controls towards the end of August and changing the signs and reprogramming the ticket machines in the areas where the two-hour maximum stay period will apply.

If you live in the red area, you will need to change your permit. We will send you a reminder letter closer to the time to let you know how to do this. If you live in the yellow, brown and green areas, you do not need to change your parking permits.

I'm sorry it's all a bit complicated, but that's to achieve the best solution for the maximum number of people. Even if the changes are not the solution you'd prefer, we hope that you'll appreciate how difficult it is to design a parking scheme everyone is happy with, but that we're making these changes in line with the majority view.

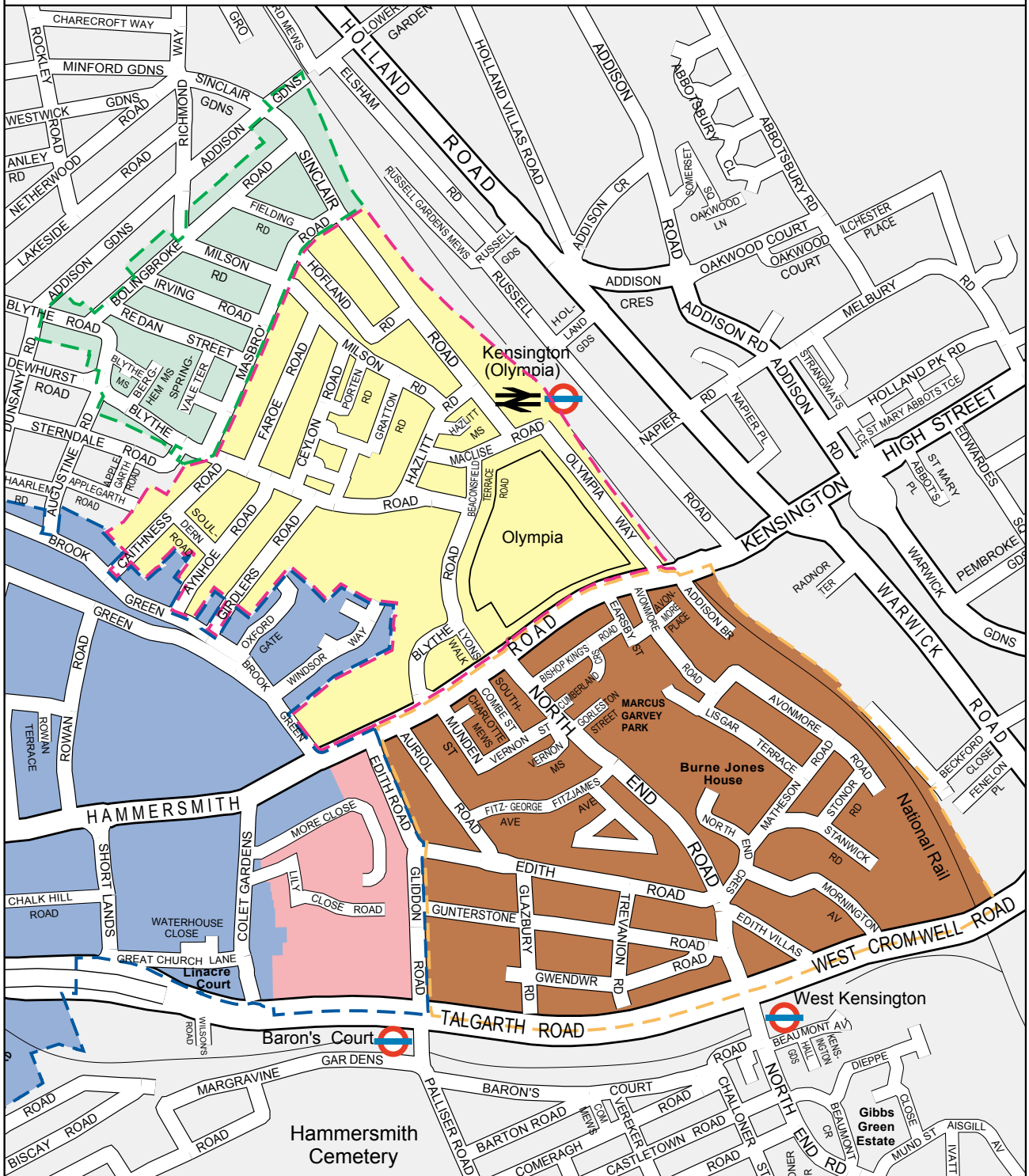


