This statement of Common Ground has been prepared jointly between the London Borough of Hammersmith and Fulham ("the Council") and Kentucky Fried Chicken (KFC). The purpose of this Statement of Common Ground (SoCG) is to inform the Inspector and other interested parties about the agreement between the Council and KFC that the following Public Health England Publication of 31st March 2017 can be added to the council's examination evidence base list:

The council submitted its Local Plan and associated evidence base to the Secretary of State on 28th February 2017. The Public Health England guidance '**Health matters: obesity and the food environment**', was published on 31st March 2017, after the council submitted its Local Plan, and it was therefore not included in the council's submitted evidence base list.

Following discussions, the Council and KFC have agreed that the document detailed above is relevant to the council's Local Plan and can retrospectively be included on the evidence base list for the Inspector to consider. However, it is also agreed by both parties that the inclusion of this document on the evidence base list does not alter KFC's ongoing concerns with the Council's Local Plan, as detailed in their Regulation 19 representations and their subsequent written statement on 22nd May 2017.
