During one session in the week, parents will be required to stay with their child. This is strongly recommended for parent/carer in supporting their child's transition into formal education. Session will cover aspects of child development and EYFS transition processes

Healthy Start

Essential daily vitamins containing vitamin D are freely available for women and children from the centre.

Is your child 2 or 3 yrs old?

You could be entitled to 15 hours funding for a nursery place. Drop in and speak to staff for further information.

A speech and language therapist will visit occasional 'stay and play sessions' to answer questions about your child's development and learning and share top tips for talking.

Back On Track (NHS) Counselling Referrals

Please ask staff for details.

Crèche support will be limited to nine spaces per session; there will be guaranteed spaces for the first five who book in advance. The ratio for the first five will be one baby and four children under the age of five; the other four spaces will depends on appropriate ratio cover in crèche services.
