

Join the fun on H&F Fireworks Night!

Dear Resident,

More than 14,000 people are expected to enjoy our 'H&F Fireworks Night' event on

- **Saturday 2 November in Ravenscourt Park.**

The gates open at 4pm and the children's fireworks will take place at 6.30pm.

The celebrations will include live music, fire performers on a live stage and will culminate with a fantastic firework display choreographed to music at 8.30pm. The event finishes at 10pm.

- £6 Early Bird tickets (available until 13 October)
- £8.30 Advance tickets (available from 14 October to 2 November)
- £8.30 box office tickets at the gates (It is likely that there will be queues in the box office. To avoid disappointment, please purchase Early Bird or Advanced tickets)
- Admission is free for children under five (please bring ID), and also for Wheelchair users and their helpers.
- Limited tickets will be available to buy on the night, the best way to guarantee entry and avoid the queue for the box office is to buy your tickets in advance.

Once you buy a ticket via Ticketmaster/Universe, a QI coded ticket will be emailed to you, which will then be scanned at the gate for quick entry on the night.

There will be no entry after 8.30pm, so **please arrive early to avoid queues.**

This year's theme: **Halloween**

This year's Halloween theme will see the main fireworks displays being accompanied by spooky, ghoulish and scary soundtracks including Halloween favourites such as; Michael Jackson's "Thriller" & "Time Warp" Rocky Horror Picture show, along with theme tunes from scary movies such as Psycho, Halloween & The Exorcist! **Some of the songs will not be suitable for small children so we suggest to arrive early and watch the children's display instead**

Throughout the event we will have live bands perform on stage, along with fire performers to wow the crowds! Stick around after the main display for more live music.

There will be a funfair, food stalls and bars serving up a wider selection of drinks than ever before. There will be no need to go looking for a cashpoint as you will be able to pay by card at the bar, food stalls and ticket box office.

Event set-up and traffic restrictions

Park access times

Event organisers will be setting up in the park ahead of the event, from: Wednesday 30th October to Friday 1 November. The Park will remain open to the public as usual.

The main area of the park will be closed to the public all day on Saturday 2 November and will re-open no later than 12pm on Sunday 3 November

The all-weather football pitch and the area on the junction of King Street and Ravenscourt Park (road) will remain open during usual park opening times

Traffic restrictions

There will be a 'no waiting or loading at any time' restriction in the roads listed below between 3pm and 11pm on Saturday 2 November:

- Goldhawk Road (east side, north & south of Ravenscourt Gardens)
- Paddenswick Road (south west side, between Goldhawk Road & Dorville Crescent)
- Ravenscourt Park, Hamlet Gardens and Ravenscourt Road.

Road Closures

Ravenscourt Avenue will be closed to all vehicles on Saturday 2 November from 3pm till 10pm

The below roads will be closed between 3pm-10pm, however **access will be allowed to residents**. When entering the road please state road you live on:

- Ravenscourt Gardens (Junction with Goldhawk Road)
- Hamlet Gardens (Junction with Ravenscourt Park)
- Ravenscourt Park (Junction with King Street)

Parking

No parking will be available outside the Paddenswick Road entrance to the park between 4pm and 10pm on Saturday 2 November.

All parking spaces on Ravenscourt Park Avenue will be suspended all day on Saturday 2 November
