Developing new homes on the former site of Hartopp Point and Lannoy Point

We are writing to update you with exciting news. We are pleased to inform you that the council has chosen Higgins Group as the construction contractor to build the new homes, following a thorough selection process that involved estate residents.

The project will deliver 134 new energy efficient new homes, the majority of which will be affordable (84%).

Higgins Group (www.higgins-group.co.uk) were selected by a panel which involved Aintree Estate residents. Higgins demonstrated a proven track record of delivering high-quality development projects and experience of working closely with neighbouring residents to minimise any potential disturbance during the works.

Preparing the site

Higgins took over the site on 31st March 2023. In the coming weeks you are likely to see preparatory works begin in line with the details of the planning consent.

From August the main construction works will begin, starting with foundations and utility connections. We are working on the detailed programme of works with Higgins and will share this information with you in due course, however the overall target is for the homes to be completed by late 2025.
