NEWSLETTER #I - JUNE 2023

Higgins Partnerships are pleased to have been appointed by Hammersmith & Fulham Council to build the two new residential blocks that will replace Hartopp Point and Lannoy Point.

We will build 134 new homes (67 for social/affordable rent, 45 for Shared Ownership and 22 available to buy as leasehold) with a mix of one-, two- and three-bedroom flats.

The new homes are due to be finished at the end of 2025.



Upcoming works on the site

So far, we have been carrying out preparatory works on the site. H&F Council have removed the wheelie bins that were being stored on the site ahead of the upcoming works. Site set-up works will be carried out between July and September, including;

- Demolishing the old substation and planters and removing the excess demolition material from the site.
- Undertaking utility works next to Dawes Road. Thames Water will need to dig the pavement in some areas to connect the site to the mains water pipe.
- Setting up cabins facing Dawes Road including a new access road. The main entrance to the site will eventually be located on Dawes Road.
- Foundation works will be carried out between September and October. This will involve holes being
 drilled into the ground to form the foundation piles for the new homes. After this, drainage ducts
 and ground slabs will be installed.

We will keep residents updated if these dates change.

CCTV will be installed inside the site for security, and to control any attempted flytipping. The cameras will be positioned to ensure the privacy of residents neighbouring the site.
