**SATURDAY SCHOOL** was launched in 1995 and is an opportunity for up to 150 pupils in Y6 from local primary schools to experience both familiar and new subjects in a senior school setting.

Taught by Latymer Upper staff, lessons are innovative and creative. Teachers are supported by our sixth form volunteers.

Participating children can be of all abilities; the Headteachers of their primary schools select those pupils who may benefit the most.
