

## **LONDON BOROUGH OF HAMMERSMITH & FULHAM** **STREET INDEX OF STATUTORY LISTED BUILDINGS**

**Last updated: 11/05/2012**

The List of Buildings of Special Architectural or Historic Interest is compiled by the Department for Culture, Media and Sport (DCMS) with the advice of English Heritage. It comprises a wide variety of buildings and structures including street furniture and tombs which are considered to be of national importance. Under Section 1 of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990, the Secretary of State at the DCMS is required to compile and amend lists of such buildings. The most recent comprehensive survey of buildings within the London Borough of Hammersmith & Fulham (H&F) resulted in the 25<sup>th</sup> List of Buildings of Special Architectural or Historic Interest, which came into effect on 14 February 1985. Since then 65 Amendments have been issued, the most recent on 11<sup>th</sup> May 2012 (Amendment Nos. 27 & 35 have never been issued).

The buildings are classified in grades to show their relative national importance as follows:-

- Grade I        These are buildings of exceptional interest (only about 2% of listed buildings).
- Grade II\*     These are particularly important buildings of more than special interest (some 4%).
- Grade II       These are buildings of special interest, which warrant every effort being made to preserve them (94% of all listed buildings).

Buildings are listed in their entirety including the exterior and interior: there is no such thing as just a listed façade. It is important to note that a listed building includes 'any object or structure fixed to the building' and 'any object or structure within the curtilage of the building which, although not fixed to the building, forms part of the land and has done so since before 1 July 1948'. Therefore a wall attached to a listed building or a building built prior to July 1948 within the curtilage of a listed building will also be listed, these are known as curtilage buildings.

**It is a criminal offence to extend, demolish or carry out internal or external alterations to a listed building without having first obtained Listed Building Consent from the Council, even if you did not know that the building was listed.**

The List of Buildings of Special Architectural or Historic Interest for H&F has been arranged into a street index below, according to their current name and address, ranked by Grade and subdivided by last known main use. It is important therefore, that when searching for a building, each grade and use is checked, particularly where the last known main use may differ from the original one. There may be more than one entry on the List for each property, particularly where walls, memorials and outbuildings are listed separately. Curtilage buildings with a separate address or name are included with the entry for the parent building on the street index.

There are approximately 500 listed buildings within the Borough. Whilst the street index is believed to be correct at the time of publication, no responsibility can be accepted for omissions or errors. Building names and addresses may change over time. Furthermore

additions and amendments to the List may be made at any time by the Secretary of State, in which case the Council will endeavour to notify the owners and occupiers of the listed building concerned. Amendment nos. were not always issued in consecutive order and ceased to be used by English Heritage after the 60th amendment was issued.

Each entry on the List has a list description which is for identification purposes only and may not include all features of special architectural or historic interest, particularly interior features. Older entries on the List may only be a few lines long whereas more recent entries will be more detailed. Please be aware that the building name and address on the street index may not be the same as that when it was originally listed.
