While no further action is needed in relation to the cladding, we are still working with our advisors on other things we can do to make Edward Woods Estate as safe as it can possibly be.

New date for fire safety meeting – Tuesday night

I wrote recently to invite you to a meeting to discuss fire safety issues on Monday night. I must apologise as we have had to change the date of the meeting.

We wanted to have someone from the London Fire Brigade come and speak and they were unable to attend on Monday night. So we have rescheduled the meeting for the following night – Tuesday 4 July.

This is not a decision I've taken lightly, but I felt it was important that you heard directly from the Fire Brigade as well as from H&F Council.
