# **Delivery of nomination papers**

2. Nomination papers must be delivered to the Returning Officer at the Electoral Services Office, Room 28, Hammersmith Town Hall, King Street, London, W6 9JU, on any weekday from the date of this Notice but no later than **4pm**, **Thursday 11 May 2017**.

## **Voter registration**

3. Applications to be included in the Register of Electors for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Room 28, Hammersmith Town Hall, King Street, London, W6 9JU no later than **Monday 22 May 2017.** 

## Postal and proxy voting

- 4. Applications to vote by post, or to cancel or amend existing postal or proxy votes, or changes from postal to proxy voting must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm, Tuesday 23 May 2017.**
- 5. New applications to vote by proxy must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm**, **Wednesday 31 May 2017.**
- 6. Applications to vote by emergency proxy because of physical incapacity or for work/ service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Thursday 8 June 2017. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 31 May 2017. To apply for work or service reasons, the person must have become aware they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday 31 May 2017.
- 7. All applications and notices regarding absent voting must be sent to the Electoral Registration Officer, Electoral Services, Room 28, Hammersmith Town Hall, King Street, London, W6 9JU
