Meeting Record

- There was a brief summary of the owners’s involvement in the market, the current traders and how it currently operates. The market was established in the 1920s and for the last 15 years it has been owned by SBM Enterprises comprising Graham Hedger and Warren Todd.
- New Shepherds Bush Market in the context of the imminent regeneration of the adjoining market site outlined their ambitions for the site.
- Cllr Cowan provided an overview of the administration’s manifesto commitments. Greatly increased emphasis and priority on delivery of more affordable housing with housing types and tenures to be genuinely affordable to a range of incomes in line with the London Plan, and an expectation that marketing of new homes would be targeted at local people and Londoners rather than foreign investors. Also described ambition to work with BBC/Stanhope and partners to get local people into jobs.
- Cllr Jones explained that any proposal for the site was likely to be sensitive and contentious.
