## Decision

Notice is hereby given that the London Borough of Hammersmith and Fulham (LBHF), pursuant to a decision made on 4 September 2017 by its Cabinet, has refused the designation of Interim Old Oak Neighbourhood Forum as a Neighbourhood Planning Forum.

## **Reasons for decision**

A neighbourhood forum is required to have a membership of at least 21 members (set out in Section 61F(5)(c) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990). On the 4<sup>th</sup> September 2017, LBHF made a decision to designate part of the neighbourhood plan area submitted by the Interim Old Oak Neighbourhood Forum. Due to the changes made to the neighbourhood area boundary, the proposed neighbourhood forum does not meet the minimum membership requirement for the designated Old Oak Neighbourhood Area and has been refused.
