**CPZ E parking consultation**

I am writing about the parking consultation we held last November and the Notice of Proposal that was published on 12<sup>th</sup> July.

**Results**

We sent you a letter in May to advise you about the changes to parking controls we were proposing to make. As part of the process to implement these controls we published the formal notice of proposal on the 12<sup>th</sup> July. However, we received a number of objections to this proposal from residents in the western half of the zone.

Having listened to your opinions, we have now adjusted the proposal and will be moving forward with a split zone, where only the streets closer to Olympia will have Sunday parking controls and a two-hour maximum stay. Those streets in the western half of the zone will remain unchanged. The attached map details the boundaries for the two zones.

**What happens next?**

The new controls will come into effect on Monday **24 October**.

*Zone EE:* Will continue to have parking controls from Monday to Saturday, 9am to 8pm, with no maximum stay.

*Zone E:* Will have parking controls that operate Monday to Sunday (including bank holidays), 9am to 8pm, with a two-hour maximum stay.

**Permits**

Whether you live in zone E or EE you will continue to have the same permit, which will be valid for both zone E and EE. This means you will not have to make any changes to your resident parking permits.

The visitors' permit scheme will also not change, so you will not have to make any changes to these. The permits will work in both zone E and EE and are not subject to the maximum stay restrictions. The permits will be free to use on Sundays in zone E.

Thank you to everyone who has taken the time to help us improve parking in your area.
